Today, we enjoyed a day of team-building activities, which allowed us to mix with children across the year group.

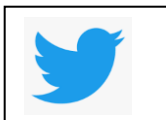
As we continue through the Summer Term, we will spend time looking at our transition into Year 7.

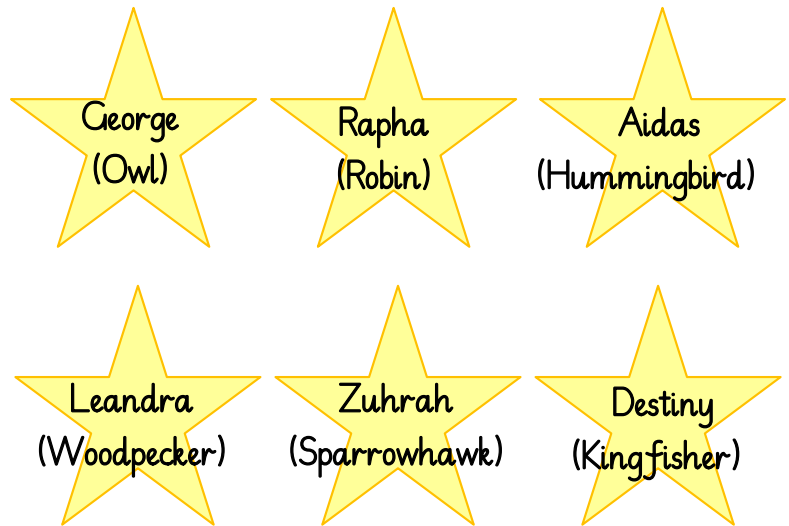
