


# **EYFS Newsletter**

### What have we been learning?

**Nursery:** This week the children have spent some time visiting the Reception classrooms and getting to know the Reception staff! We have been preparing for our transition into Year 1, by thinking about important things we would like our new teacher to know about us. The children visited the Year 1 classrooms this week, to familiarise themselves with the environment and to take part in a Year 1 style lesson which they really enjoyed!
