What have we been learning?

Year 3

This week we created a loop program in Scratch and will continue to add program commands to our animation program, next week. In English, we used descriptive language to create a setting and a monster with special abilities who captures people. We will be using our ideas to create a story about defeating a powerful monster over the coming weeks. In maths, we revised multiplication by solving complex word problems and next week we will look at division word problems.

Year 4

Our scientific enquiry has helped us to understand and group different materials into solids, liquids and gases and identifying them using their properties. This week we have learned about Julius Caesar and the first invasion of Britain by the Roman army and gaining a better understanding of how the Roman Empire grew. In English, we are taking on the role of journalists to report of the volcanic eruption of Munt Vesuvius.
