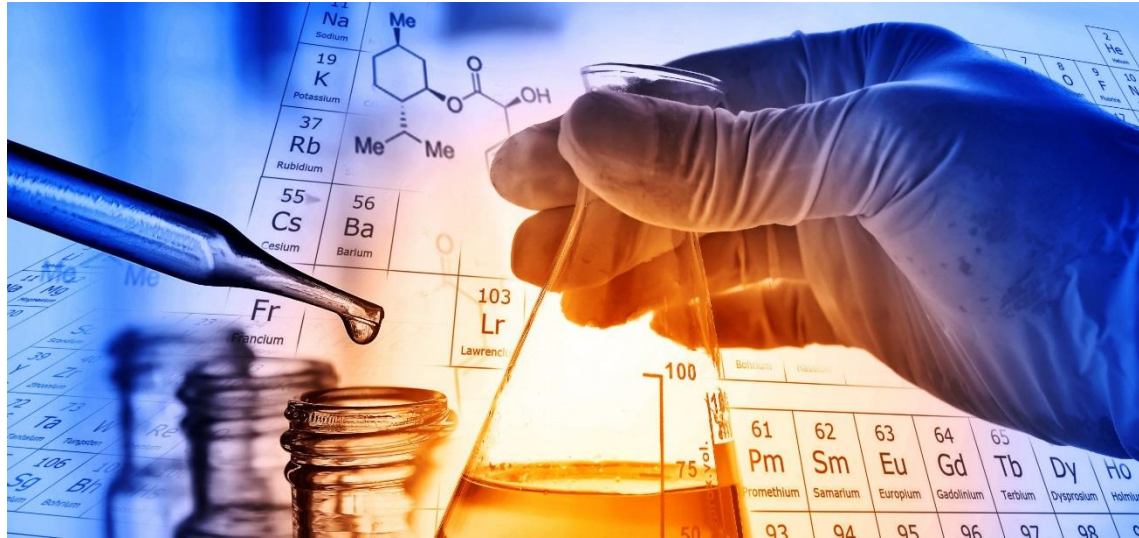




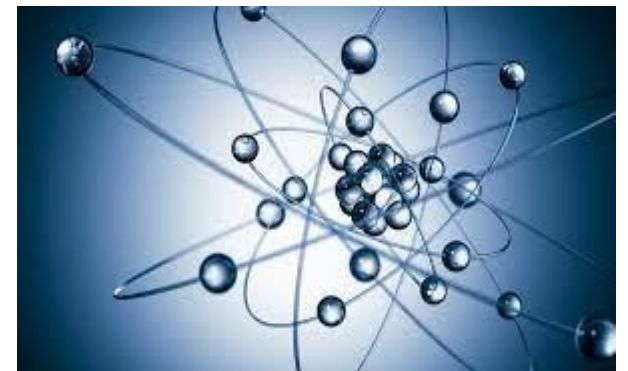
Science





What is Science?

What lives in the deepest depths of the ocean?

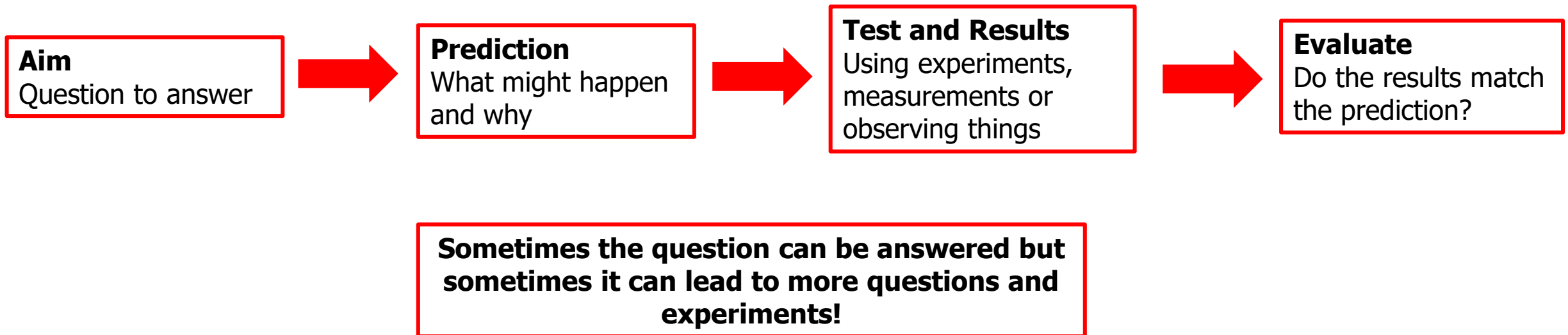
How many lemurs are left in the wild?

What do scientists do?

Scientists are explorers finding out about the world and everything in it. They investigate and experiment to find the answers to their questions.





Some questions that scientists have asked...

How speedy is a cheetah?

Scientists attached special tracking collars to five cheetahs in Botswana, Africa. They tracked the animals for 17 months and carefully worked through all the data they collected. They discovered that, when hunting, the cheetahs accelerated faster than most cars, going from zero to 60mph in just 3 seconds!





Some questions that scientists have asked...

How intelligent are crows?

Scientists wanted to find out if crows can use tools to help them get food, a sign of intelligence. They set up a test for eight crows in a laboratory. The crows were shown a box with a tasty snack in it, along with some bits of stick and thin tubes. All of the birds worked out how to put these together to make a tool to poke the food out of the box!
