Your present circumstances don't determine where you can go; they merely determine where you start.

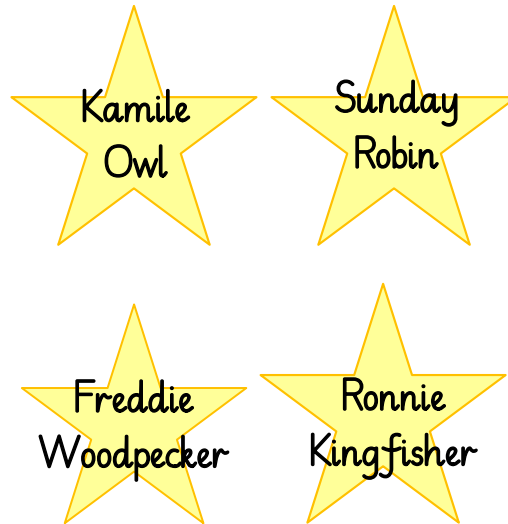
