"Always keep your eyes open. Keep watching because whatever you see can inspire you."

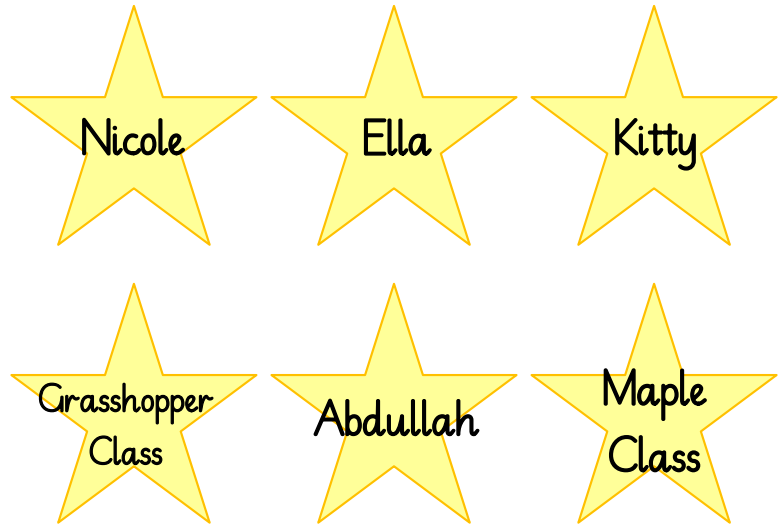
