Year 2 This week, we have been becoming wildlife reporters and learnt some facts about different animals. We are looking forward to using these facts in a nonchronological report.


Year 3 We really enjoyed our trip to the National Gallery. In English, we are writing our own story, whilst in Maths we have been comparing numbers to 1000.


