




**Focus:** We will be writing a character description and diary entries.































**Entry Point** – Watching *Oliver!* The musical

<u>History –</u> We will be learning about the changing power of monarchs in British history.

### **Activities:**

- What does the monarchy mean to you and your family? Discuss and write down your points.
- Can you find out the names and information of past monarchs.

**Key Vocabulary:** Absolute power, constitutional monarchy, hereditary, empire, colony

**Key questions:** How has the power of monarchy changed?

# <u>Science – We are learning about how light travels.</u>

### **Activities:**

- Look closely at your eye through a mirror and identify the features
- Measure your shadow at different times throughout the day and see what happens.

**<u>Key Vocabulary:</u>** light, light source, transparent, translucent, opaque, reflect, light rays, shadow

**Key Questions:** How does light travel and reflect?

# <u>PE</u> – We will play basketball and the skills needed for a game. Activities:

- Research famous basketball players and their careers.
- Watch basketball games on TV.

Key Vocabulary: defence, attack, position, steal, dribbling

**Key questions**: What are the rules of basketball?

# <u>RE</u> – We will be learning about the purpose of places of worship and views that religions share with the world.

### **Activities:**


- Visit a Church and Mosque and interview members of that community.

**Key Vocabulary:** holy place, ritual, worship, belief, religious figure **Key questions:** What similarities and differences do religions share?

# <u>Design and Technology –</u> We will be designing and making our own frame structures. Activities:

- Look at different structures around your home such as an umbrella or even a tent and analyse how each is being held together.

**Key Vocabulary:** frame structure, reinforce, triangulation, stability, temporary, permanent **Key questions:** How do we design and create a shelter?
