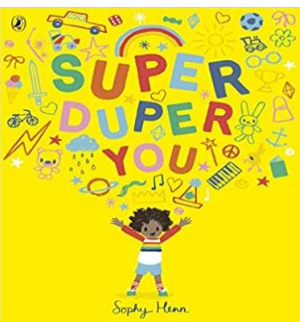
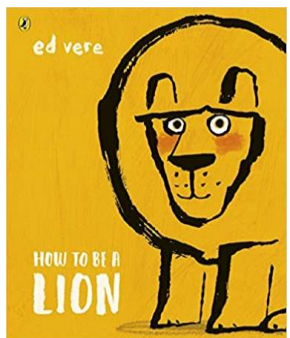
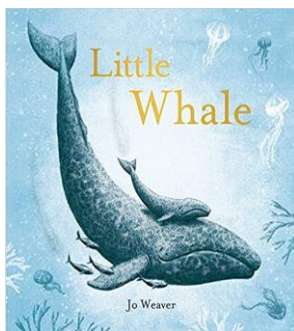
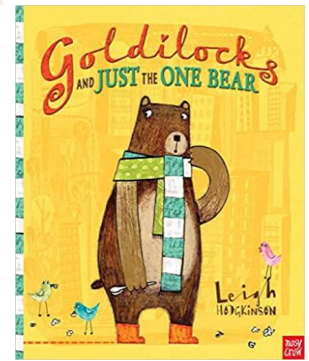
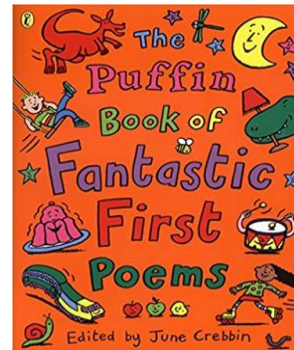
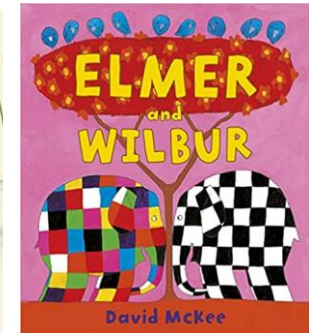
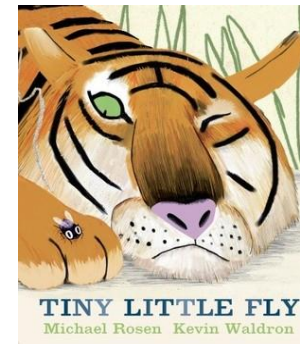
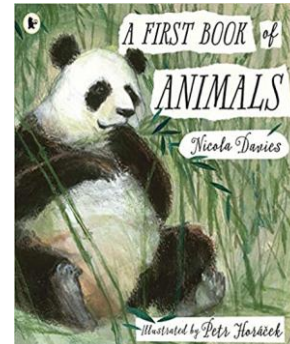
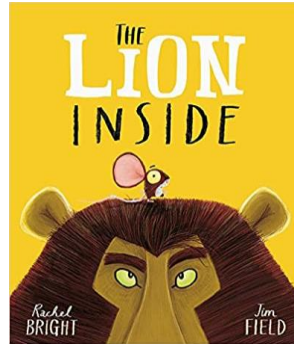
Focus: We will be writing a character description and poems.

Entry Point – What makes me special? / Making a class collage of Elmer

Geography – human features, physical feature, manmade, town, countryside

We will be learning about how our local area is different to the countryside.

Key question: What kind of place do you live in?

Activity: Google Earth where you live and then where an elephant would live. What is the same? What is different?



DT – fabric, joining, running stitch, finishing, technique, fastening, sewing, gluing

We will be learning all about different ways of joining materials to create a hand puppet.

Key question: What is sewing?

Activities: Explore any puppets you have at home. How have they been made?



PE - slide, pathway, push, pull, travel, rock, roll,

We will be learning how to combine a range of movements to create a patterned routine in gymnastics.

Key questions: How many different ways can you travel?

Activities: Hold a tricky 'balance'. How long can you hold this for?

We will be learning about and naming different groups of animals.

Key questions: How many different types of animal can you name?

Activities:

Draw your favourite animal labelling the parts of the body.

We will be learning all about being healthy and safe and how to make healthy lifestyle choices.

Key question: What does being healthy mean?

Activities:

Complete a Joe Wicks workout!

Computing - pictogram, data, graph

We will be learning about how we can group things differently then how to display the information using tally charts and pictograms.

Key question: What kinds of things can we sort?

Activities: Make a simple tally chart collecting some information.
