



























Entry Point – Immersion into Flotsam text

<u>Science</u> – We will be classifying and comparing different species of organisms.

Activities:

- Go for a walk around the park – what different plants can you see? **Key Vocabulary:** organisms, plants, animals, micro-organisms, classification, group, characteristics.

Key questions:

What do all living things need to survive? How can we group different types of living things?

<u>PE-</u> We will be creating various balances in Gymnastics. Activities:

- Who are Great Britain's top gymnasts? Research the person and their main gymnastic talents.

Key Vocabulary:

balance, travel, pike, v-shape, star, jump, roll

Key Questions: How can you create a sequence using different balances and travels?

Year 6 – Spring Term 2

<u>Maths – We</u> will be looking at a range of reasoning questions, covering timetables, Roman Numerals, ratio and proportion and algebra. Activities:

- Practise reading a train timetable or TV guide.

Key Vocabulary: departure arrival, duration, parts

Key questions:

What is the duration of the film? How could you make a recipe to feed 4 people, feed 6?

<u>Art</u> – We will be making collages of different under water scenes.

Activities:

 Collect recycling at home and experiment with them, identifying the different textures and patterns you can make with them.

<u>Key Vocabulary:</u> collage, textures, materials.

Key questions:

How can we create different textures in a collage? What different types of collage are there?

<u>PSHE</u>- We will be celebrating differences <u>Activities:</u>

- Research someone who has a disability but has been able to achieve great things in life.

<u>Key Vocabulary:</u> power, struggle, imbalance, control, harassment, bullying

Key Questions: How can differences be a source of conflict and a cause for celebration?

<u>RE – We will be learning about the Christian festival of Easter.</u>

Activities:

- Research what the significance is of the chocolate egg that is eaten in Easter.

Key Vocabulary: Easter, resurrection, Jesus Christ, tomb,

messiah, disciples

Key questions: What are the sources of the story of Easter?
