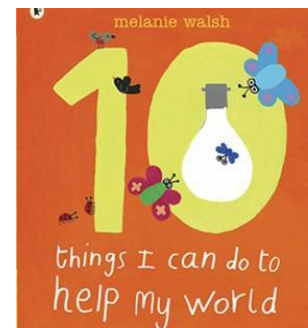
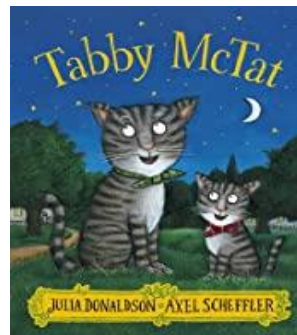
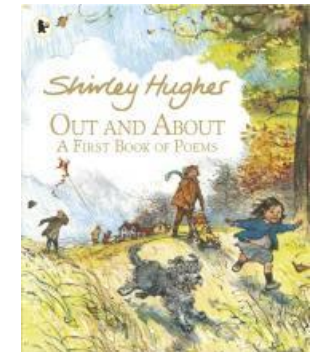
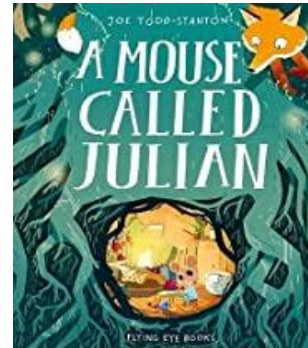
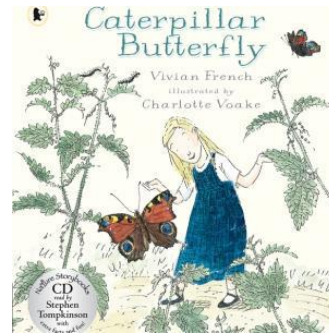
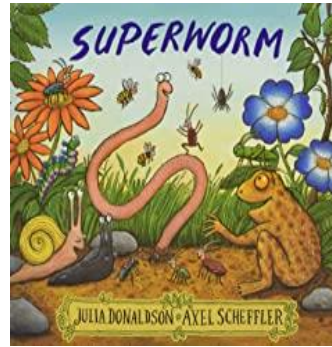


Focus

We will be writing an overcoming the monster story.

Entry Point – ‘Treasure hunt – Can we find Jack’s magic beans? (Planting a beanstalk)

Geography - north, east, south, west, compass, left, right, direction, map, route

We will be exploring compass points and using these to follow directions on maps.

Key questions: What are the points on a compass?

Activities: Go onto Google maps and look at a map of where you live.



PE – speed, agility, co-ordination, fitness, energy, health

Key questions: How can we stay fit?

Activities: Go for a jog with your family at your local park.



DT – Proteins, carbohydrates, dairy, fruit and vegetables, oils and spreads, healthy, balanced, diet.

We will be learning all about different food groups and finding out where our food comes from.

Key question: Where does our food come from?



Activities: Look in your cupboards and fridge – Can you identify which food groups the items belong to?

Science – Leaf, flower, blossom, petal, fruit, berry, root, seed, trunk, branch, stem, bark, stalk, bud

This half term we will be learning all about different plants, naming them and learning about the key parts of plants.

Key questions: How many plants can you name?

Activities: Go on a nature walk and see how many plants you can recognise.



Art – collage, stick, layer, materials, natural,

We will be exploring the work of Andy Goldsworthy and learning how to create a collage using natural resources.



Key Question: How do we collage using natural materials?

Activities: Can you go on local walk and collect natural resources?

RE – community, Muhammad, mosque, Eid, Qur’an, leadership, Muslim, Islam

We will be learning all about Islamic traditions, special objects and celebrations.



Key question: What does it mean to be a Muslim?

Activities: Think about groups you belong to.

Computing - pictogram, data, graph

We will be learning about how we can group things differently and add labels.

Key question: What kinds of objects can we sort?

Activities: Make a simple tally chart collecting some information.



PSHE – relationships, family, friend, special, contact, help

We will be learning about relationships with family and friends and important qualities to support these relationships.

Key question: What makes a good friend?

Activities: Make something special for a friend.
